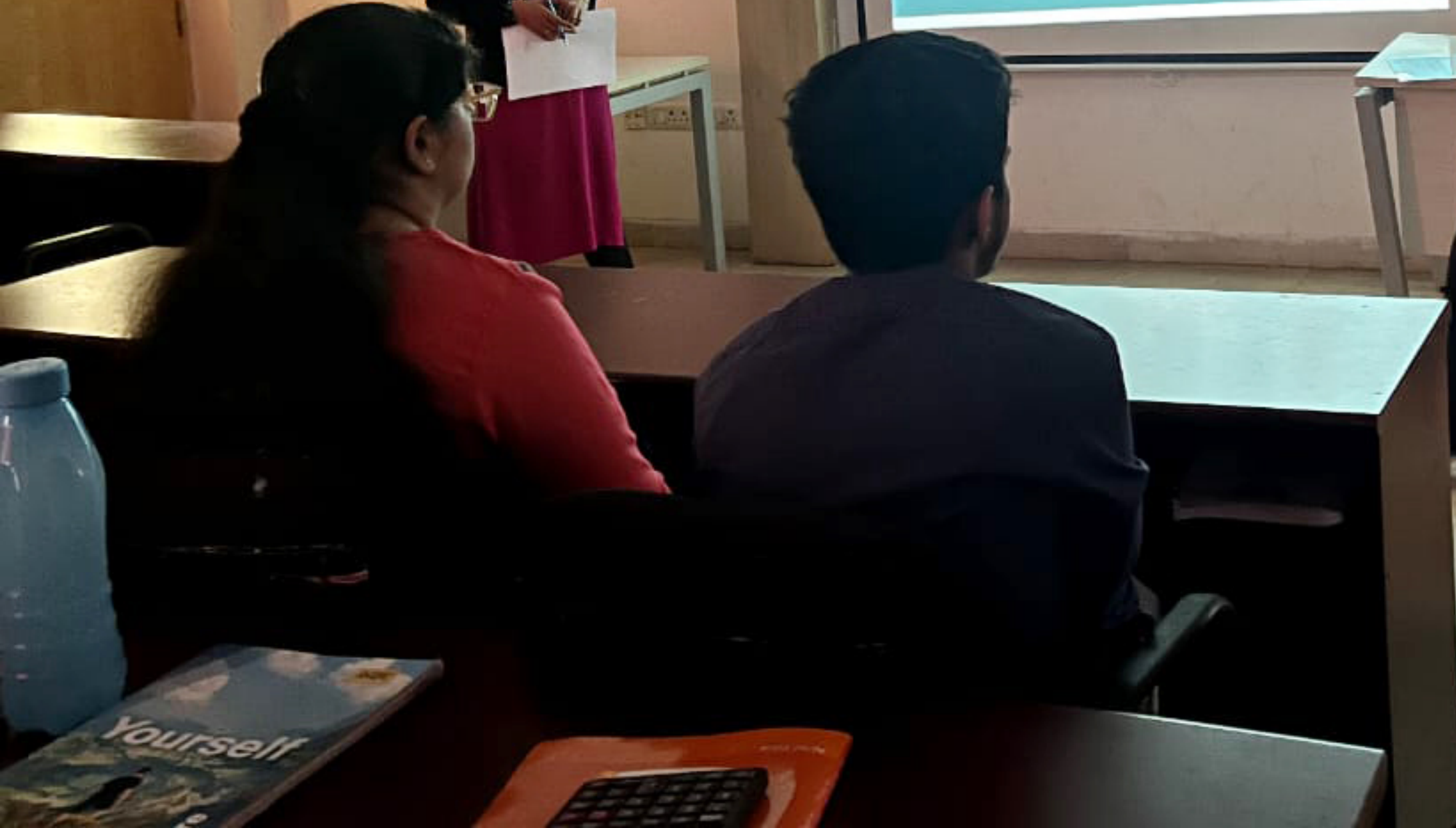

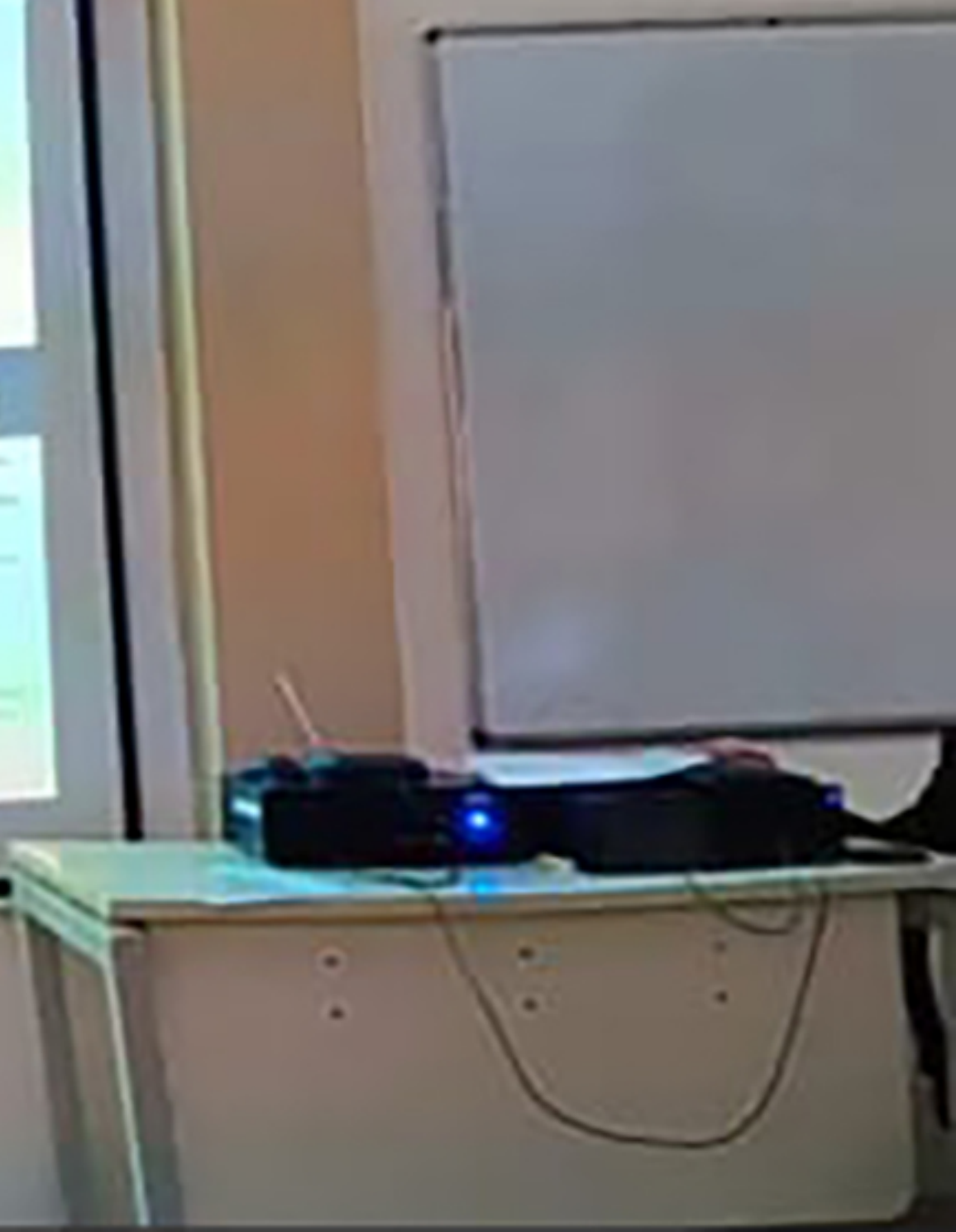


Cyber crime cases shoot up post demonetisation

Post demonetisation of the Rs 500 and Rs 1,000 notes, a number of banks, mobile applications and a number have been targeted by hackers.

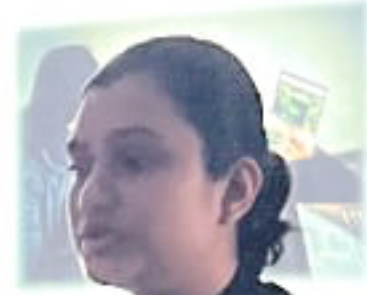
